**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ASOTIN COUNTY PUBLIC FACILITIES
DISTRICT ADOPTING A FULL TIME EMPLOYEE COVID-19 EMERGENCY CLOSURE WAGES
POLICY**

WHEREAS, the Asotin County Public Facilities District Board of Directors is empowered to establish the compensation for full time staff of the Asotin County Family Aquatic Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors hereby approves the wages of all full time staff to include emergency closure wages equivalent to their regular scheduled full time wages in the event of illness due to COVID-19, exposure to a sick co-worker, mandatory/required social distancing, government mandated facility closures, or any additional COVID-19 related incidences resulting in the forced layoff or temporary involuntary unemployment of full time staff; and


WHEREAS, essential staff who are required to continue to report to work during the event of an emergency closure in order to fulfill crucial functions and maintain vital operations of the facility will receive a rate of time and half their normal hourly rate of pay;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Asotin County Public Facilities District does hereby declare as stated above, this emergency closure wages policy for full time hourly staff of the Asotin County Family Aquatic Center during the event of unemployment due to involuntary COVID-19 related incidences;


